

Amador High School Dance Guidelines and Policies



General Guidelines for All Dances

- Students attending AHS dances will be admitted no later than one hour after the starting time. Students **must** make arrangements with the administration before the dance if an exception is required.
- After arriving to the dance, students may not leave and re-enter.
- **There is NO back to front dancing. Partners must face each other at all times.**
- Touching or rubbing another person in a distasteful or sexual manner is not allowed.
- Students will be warned one time if they violate the rules. A second notice will result in dismissal from the dance and parent notification.
- The school reserves the right to breathalyzer test/or search students who demonstrate suspicious behavior possibly due to illegal substances.

Dress Code for Dances

The Homecoming dance is semi-formal:

Boys: Dress pants or khakis, button down shirt with collar, dress shoes. No ball caps.

Girls: Dresses in good taste and length must be at least mid-thigh with arms extended at side; strapless is ok; no midriff or see-through fabric; dress shoes.

The Winter Formal and Prom are formal:

Boys: Suit or tuxedo; dress shoes (no tennis shoes); collared button down shirt, tie. No ball caps.

Girls: Formal dress (same design as above) and dress shoes; no midriff or see-through fabric; strapless is ok.
